All Saints Preschool Programs

3 year old program

- Meets Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:00-11:30 AM
- Maximum of 16 children per class who are supervised by one teacher and one teacher associate
- Children must be 3 years old and toilet trained to enroll

The main emphasis of our 3 year old program is on the social development. We value play as an appropriate way of learning and will assist children with their communication and social skills as they develop relationships with other children and engage in solitary, parallel, and cooperative play.

Throughout the year we will introduce a variety of skills such as:

- ✓ colors and shapes
- ✓ fine motor skills such as writing, cutting
- ✓ self-help skills
- ✓ counting



4 year old program

- Meets Monday-Wednesday-Friday mornings from 9:00-11:30 AM
- **Or**
Monday-Tuesday-Thursday-Friday afternoons from 1:00-3:30 PM
- Maximum of 18 children per class who are supervised by one teacher and one teacher associate
- Children must be 4 years old by September 15 to enroll

The main emphasis of our 4 year old program continues to place great value on the social development, as well as the cognitive development as we begin to concentrate on Kindergarten readiness skills.

Throughout the year we will work on a variety of skills such as:

- ✓ counting and number recognition
- ✓ alphabet recognition
- ✓ phonemic awareness
- ✓ writing first and last names

Enrichment program

- Meets Monday-Tuesday-Thursday-Friday afternoons from 1:00-3:30 PM
- Maximum of 18 children per class who are supervised by one teacher and one teacher associate
- Children must be 5 years old by December 31 to enroll

The Enrichment program is an extension of the 4 year old program designed to serve the older 4 and 5 year old children. This class provides the link between preschool and kindergarten. We will enrich the child's cognitive development through exploratory learning centers designed around the core curriculum areas: Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and Art.

Throughout the year we will work on a variety of skills such as:

- ✓ alphabet recognition
- ✓ "letter of the week"
- ✓ phonemic awareness
- ✓ math readiness skills
- ✓ classroom responsibility
