Holy Family System Parents/Guardians:

The Holy Family Board of Education with much input from the finance committee is working on the budget and will be setting tuition for next year. The goal is to keep tuition increase to a minimum.

The State of Iowa provides tax credits to parents who send their children to private school. It is 25% for each student of the first \$1,000 or a tax credit of \$250.00. This does include expenses for extra curricular activities, speech, music, drama and so on.

Catholic Schools Week is January 30 to February 3rd. The theme for this year is: "Catholic Schools: Faith, Academics, Service". This is time set aside to celebrate the unique and wonderful educational offerings of Holy Family. We encourage you to enjoy the special evening events at St. Jude and St. Ludmila. St. Jude has open classrooms and a Chili Supper on January 31st and St. Ludmila has open classrooms with Chicken Noodle and Kolach Supper on February 2nd. We encourage prospective elementary students and parents to take advantage of these evenings to tour the schools and meet the staff. LaSalle precedes Catholic Schools Week with "Celebrate LaSalle Night" on January 23. We hope anyone interested in the LaSalle Center will attend. 4th grade students are especially encouraged to attend. Activities on January 23 include a spaghetti dinner, each LaSalle student will have a Lancer mascot poster decorated to symbolize LaSalle in their life, a special photography display from the Robert Campagna Photography workshop, and student entertainment. We are anxious to show case the entire LaSalle program. It is a great chance to meet teachers and staff; tour the building while learning about our 5th through 8th grade programs, and check out the many talents of our student body.

Finally, the STO had a goal of \$3.67 million dollars to aid with tuition in the Archdiocese of Dubuque. Thank you to all who helped with this by making a donation. We made our goal and over \$300,000 had to be returned. STO will help to keep parish subsidy and tuition in line, particularly as the state allows us to raise more and more money for this cause. We want to make sure a Catholic School education is available to all.

Asbestos Notification

Asbestos is an issue we have been dealing with for many years. The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act of 1986, AHERA, was enacted by Congress to determine the extent of and develop solutions for any problems schools may have with asbestos. Holy Family has their buildings inspected on a regular basis by a certified asbestos inspector, as required by AHERA. A copy of the asbestos management plan is available at each school center. We continue to implement our asbestos management plans. It is our intent to comply with Federal, state and local regulations in this area. We plan to take all necessary steps to insure that your child(ren) and our employees have a healthy and safe environment in which to learn and work.
